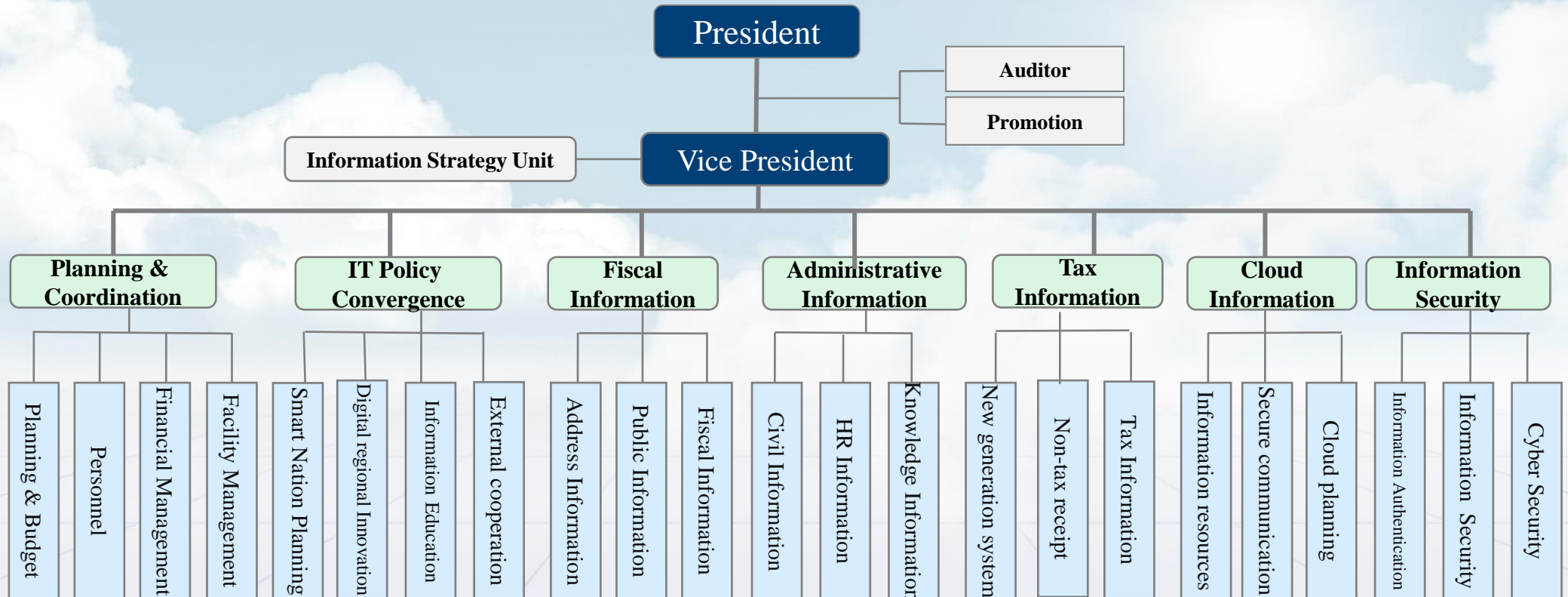

3. Main Task 1: Operation of Local e-Government Systems

Providing reliable services to citizens through advanced information protection against cyber-attacks

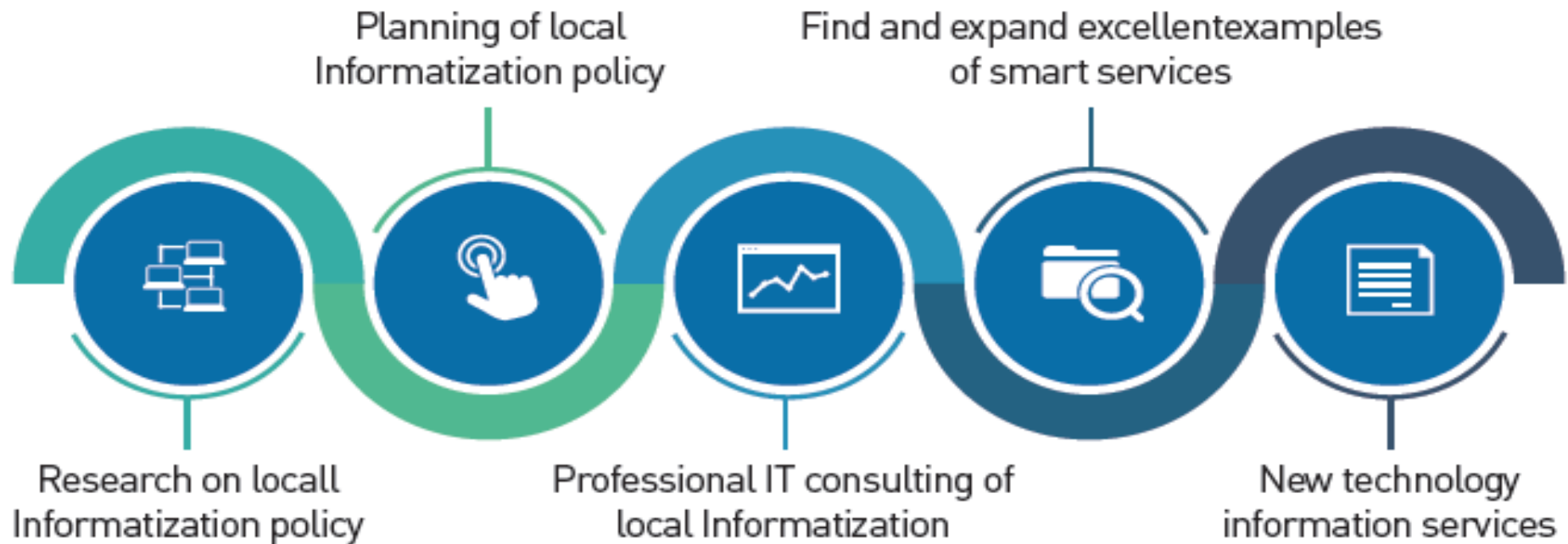


- E-government certification and **Information protection service**
